

Approved Uses

BOTOX* Cosmetic (onabotulinumtoxinA) is a prescription medicine that is injected into muscles and used to temporarily improve the look of both moderate to severe crow's feet lines and frown lines between the eyebrows in adults.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

BOTOX° Cosmetic may cause serious side effects that can be life threatening. Get medical help right away if you have any of these problems any time (hours to weeks) after injection of BOTOX° Cosmetic:

- Problems swallowing, speaking, or breathing, due to weakening of associated muscles, can be severe and result in loss of life. You are at the highest risk if these problems are pre-existing before injection. Swallowing problems may last for several months
- Spread of toxin effects. The effect of botulinum toxin may affect areas away from the injection site and cause serious symptoms including: loss of strength and allover muscle weakness, double vision, blurred vision and drooping eyelids, hoarseness or change or loss of voice, trouble saying words clearly, loss of bladder control, trouble breathing, trouble swallowing

BOTOX° Cosmetic dosing units are not the same as, or comparable to, any other botulinum toxin product.

There has not been a confirmed serious case of spread of toxin effect when BOTOX* Cosmetic has been used at the recommended dose to treat frown lines, crow's feet lines, or both at the same time.

BOTOX° Cosmetic (onabotulinumtoxinA) may cause loss of strength or general muscle weakness, vision problems, or dizziness within hours to weeks of taking BOTOX° Cosmetic. If this happens, do not drive a car, operate machinery, or do other dangerous activities.

Serious and/or immediate allergic reactions have been reported. They include: itching, rash, red itchy welts, wheezing, asthma symptoms, or dizziness or feeling faint. Get medical help right away if you are wheezing or have asthma symptoms, or if you become dizzy or faint.

Do not take BOTOX* Cosmetic if you: are allergic to any of the ingredients in BOTOX* Cosmetic (see Medication Guide for ingredients); had an allergic reaction to any other botulinum toxin product such as *Myobloc** (rimabotulinumtoxinB), *Dysport** (abobotulinumtoxinA), or *Xeomin** (incobotulinumtoxinA); have a skin infection at the planned injection site.

Tell your doctor about all your muscle or nerve conditions, such as ALS or Lou Gehrig's disease, myasthenia gravis, or Lambert-Eaton syndrome, as you may be at increased risk of serious side effects including difficulty swallowing and difficulty breathing from typical doses of BOTOX* Cosmetic.

What it is

BOTOX® Cosmetic (onabotulinumtoxinA) is a doctor-administered injection that is inserted into your muscles to temporarily smooth the lines around the sides of your eyes and between your brows—also called moderate to severe crow's feet and frown lines.

Where your doctor will inject

How it works

BOTOX® Cosmetic targets one of the underlying causes of crow's feet and frown lines—muscle contractions from squinting and frowning. BOTOX® Cosmetic temporarily reduces this muscle activity so you'll begin to notice a visible smoothing of these lines.



What it's made from

BOTOX® Cosmetic is made from sources that exist in nature. It contains tiny amounts of a highly purified protein.

Common side effects

In clinical studies, 3% of patients experienced eyelid drooping in the frown lines studies and 1% of patients experienced eyelid swelling in the crow's feet studies. Other possible side effects include: discomfort or pain at the injection site; headache; and eye problems: double vision, blurred vision, drooping eyelids, and swelling of your eyelids. BOTOX* Cosmetic (onabotulinumtoxinA) subtly smoothes the lines around your eyes and between your brows so you'll look like yourself—not fake or "done."



Tell your doctor about all your medical conditions, including: plans to have surgery; had surgery on your face; weakness of forehead muscles: trouble raising your eyebrows; drooping eyelids; any other abnormal facial change; are pregnant or plan to become pregnant (it is not known if BOTOX* Cosmetic can harm your unborn baby); are breastfeeding or plan to (it is not known if BOTOX* Cosmetic passes into breast milk).



Photos taken at maximum frown and/or full smile before and after treatment with BOTOX $^{\circ}$ Cosmetic (onabotulinumtoxinA) at day 7. In two clinical studies for moderate to severe crow's feet, 26.1% and 20.3% of people had \geq 2-grade improvement at day 30. In one of these studies, 67.9% of people had mild or no crow's feet at day 30 after treatment. In clinical studies for moderate to severe frown lines, physicians assessed 80% of people had significant improvement at day 30.

Side effects associated with the injection include localized pain, infection, inflammation, tenderness, swelling, redness, and/or bleeding/bruising.

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
